Jenks High School Pom is beginning another exciting year. Tryouts for the 2017-2018 school year have taken place and practices have begun. Our 4 teams: Middle School, Freshman, JV, and Varsity will be attending Universal Dance Association Camp this summer with the goal of qualifying for the National Dance Team Championship in Orlando, FL in February 2018.

The girls of Jenks Pom participate in sideline and half-time performances during football and basketball games, as well as competing at regional, state, and national competitions. They participate in community service projects and are top students at Jenks High School. We are honored and proud of all of our squads. Last year, our Middle School squad, Freshman, and Varsity Squads won the title of 2016 State Champions for their divisions. At the 2017 National Dance Championship, the Freshman squad placed first, our JV squad placed 3rd, and our Varsity squad placed 5th in the nation. It is exciting to see the hard work and months of practice pay-off for these amazingly dedicated young women.

Each girl is responsible for paying for camp and competition registrations, choreography, dance shoes and costumes, travel expenses, and coaching fees.
